First Steps

Word Count (1500-2500 words)

title's length (up to 12 words) and relevance to the article

Editing

Headings and Subchapters -- clear structure (Introduction, Main Points, Conclusion)

Footnote Numbers after punctuation marks

No double footnote numbers, if there are two+ sources for the same sentence, use one footnote connecting the two references with ";"

"" instead of «»

Quotes in italics

Emphasis in italics, not bold

Words not in English should be in italics

Case law in italics

-no space-

Footnotes

Full stops at the end of each footnote

Links for online sources

Access dates before links [Accessed August 23, 2022.]

Italics where needed

Correct format of author names

Correct format of publication dates
